COURSE DESCRIPTOR:

This Qualification reflects the role of skilled operators working within the Civil Construction industry, who applies a broad range of skills in a varied work context using discretion, judgement and relevant theoretical knowledge

OUTCOMES:

Job roles and titles vary across different industry sectors. Possible job roles relevant to this qualification include: Plant Operator in: Civil Construction Industry Mining Industry Municipal Operations Rural Industry Worker Earthmoving & Excavation.

ELEMENTS OF QUALIFICATION:

Certificate III in Civil Construction Plant Operations consists of 16 units:

- Ten core units
- Six elective units draw from Plant Operations Elective List.
- Including four plant competencies, consisting of:
 - Skidsteer
 - Wheeled Front End Loader
 - Excavator
 - Backhoe/Loader

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

An appointment must be made for an interview to establish suitability.

Participants must be a minimum of 18 yrs of age.

COURSE DURATION:

Full time courses are conducted at the Aust-Link training facility for a duration of two days a week over 12 months. Times: 8.30am – 4.30pm

Course Ratio: Minimum 10 participants.
