ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

1. Participants must be **18 years** of age
2. Provide two forms of identity for enrolment paperwork (Drivers licence, Medicare, Passport, Birth Cert etc.)
3. Wear appropriate clothing and footwear
4. Be proficient in English
 - *Identify any areas where participants may need additional support*
 - *Minimum written and /or oral English level*

The Construction Induction program is designed to train participants to work safely in the construction industry in line with WorkSafe licencing requirements.

The Construction Induction Card is Mandatory for people performing construction work in Victoria.

This card is issued for life and is recognised throughout Australia.

While waiting to receive your Construction Induction card to be issued, the Statement of Attainment issued by the RTO can be used as proof of having successfully completed the program.

CERTIFICATION

At successful completion of this program a Statement of Attainment will be issued to the student, reflecting the National unit of competency achieved. Training conducted in this course aligns to the new Worksafe Safety Requirements for undertaking construction work which came into effect on 1 July 2008
