



# HEAVY RIGID

## 3 DAY PROGRAM

## FACT SHEET

### DURATION

This program is conducted over 3 days. (8.00am – 4.30pm)

**Day 1:** Classroom theory & VicRoads Knowledge Test.

**Day 2:** Practical training on road and off road reversing.

**Day 3:** Continued practical training, followed by the commencement of the VicRoads licence assessment.

### TRAINER/STUDENT RATIO

1:4 Theory

1:1 Practical (maximum).

### ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

1. The applicant has held an Australian driver licence to drive a car for a period of at least 24 months without suspension or cancellation.
2. Provide two forms of identity for enrolment paperwork (Drivers licence, Medicare, Passport etc.)
3. Must notify staff of any medical conditions/medication taken and receive Medical approval from VicRoads.  
*NOTE: VicRoads require all students to declare if they have any Medical Conditions and/or taking any prescribed medications. A medical report will be required to be submitted to VicRoads Medical for approval prior to the program commencement. Please talk to the friendly Aust-Link staff about VicRoads Medical declarations and requirements.*
4. Pass Eyesight test conducted by Aust-Link.
5. Wear appropriate clothing and footwear.
6. Be proficient in English
  - *Identify any areas where participants may need additional support*
  - *Minimum written and /or oral English level*
7. Purchase and be familiar with the Vic Roads Bus and Truck Driver handbook.
8. Be able to drive a car fitted with a manual transmission as Aust-Links Heavy Rigid Vehicles are either Synchromesh Transmission or Non Synchromesh Transmission.

*Mildura Office - Both Synchromesh Transmission or*

*Non Synchromesh Transmission vehicles available.*

*Bendigo Office - Synchro Transmission vehicle ONLY.*

### PROGRAM FEES & CHARGES

Please contact Aust-Link program coordinator as program fees and charges are subject to change. Fees are broken down into Program Fees, Fuel Levy Fees, Tuition Fees, Material Fees & Amenities Fees. The VicRoads Licence Fee is additional and is to be paid directly to VicRoads after the successful completion of the program.

### PROGRAM OUTLINE & OBJECTIVES

This accredited VicRoads program is designed for drivers seeking to upgrade their licence to obtain a Heavy Rigid Vehicle Licence. A Heavy Rigid vehicle is described as a vehicle with 3 or more axles, including truck or bus, greater than 8 tonnes GVM.

By completing the 3 day program, students will receive adequate theory and practical training to attempt the VicRoads Licence Assessment.

### CERTIFICATION

Aust-Link will issue a Statement of Attainment to the successful participant on completion of this program.
