

#### DURATION

This program is conducted over 1 day. (8.00am – 4.30pm)

Training consists of classroom theory training and VicRoads Knowledge Assessment, followed by on & off road practical training.

Once deemed satisfactory the VicRoads Licence assessment will be conducted as per VicRoads regulations.

#### TRAINER/STUDENT RATIO

1:1 (maximum).

#### ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

1. Hold a current Victorian Drivers Licence for a minimum of 12 months without suspension or cancellation.
  2. **Participant must provide a Light Rigid Vehicle conforming to vehicle checklist requirements.**  
*(This checklist can be obtained from the Aust-Link office).*
  3. Provide two forms of identity for enrolment paperwork (Drivers licence, Medicare, Passport etc.)
  4. Must notify staff of any medical conditions/medication taken and receive Medical approval from VicRoads.
- NOTE:** VicRoads require all students to declare if they have any Medical Conditions and/or taking any prescribed medications. A medical report will be required to be submitted to VicRoads Medical for approval prior to the program commencement. Please talk to the friendly Aust-Link staff about VicRoads Medical declarations and requirements.
5. Pass Eyesight test conducted by Aust-Link.
  6. Wear appropriate clothing and footwear.
  7. Be proficient in English
    - Identify any areas where participants may need additional support
    - Minimum written and /or oral English level
  8. Purchase and be familiar with the Vic Roads Bus and Truck Driver handbook.

#### PROGRAM FEES & CHARGES

Please contact Aust-Link program coordinator as program fees and charges are subject to change. Fees are broken down into Program Fees, Tuition Fees, Material Fees & Amenities Fees. The VicRoads Licence Fee is additional and is to be paid directly to VicRoads after the successful completion of the program.

#### PROGRAM OUTLINE & OBJECTIVES

This accredited VicRoads program is designed for drivers seeking to upgrade their drivers licence to obtain a Light Rigid Vehicle Licence.

A Light Rigid vehicle is described as any rigid vehicle, including buses and trucks, greater than 4.5 tonnes GVM but equal to or less than 8 tonnes GVM or seating more than 12 adults including the driver.
