# LIGHT RIGID LICENCE

### PROGRAM OUTLINE.

This accredited VicRoads program is designed for drivers seeking to upgrade their licence to obtain a Light Rigid Vehicle Licence.

A Light Rigid vehicle is described as any rigid vehicle, including truck or bus, greater than 4.5 tonnes GVM or seating more than 12 adults including the driver.

### DURATION.

Program is conducted over 1 day  
Training consists of theory training and Secure Cargo assessment, followed by on & off road training. Once deemed satisfactory the VicRoads Licence assessment will be conducted as per VicRoads regulations.

### TRAINER/STUDENT RATIO.

1:1 (maximum).

### ENTRY REQUIREMENTS.

#### Participants must:

- Hold a current Victorian Motor Car Licence.
- Have held their car licence for a minimum of 12 months.
- Provide primary and secondary proof of identification prior to program commencement.
- Eyesight test conducted by Aust-Link.
- Must notify staff of any medical conditions/medication taken.
- Purchase and be familiar with the Vic Roads Bus and Truck Driver handbook.
- Be able to drive a car fitted with a manual transmission.
- **Participant must provide a Light Rigid Vehicle conforming to vehicle checklist requirements. This checklist can be obtained from the Aust-Link office.**

- Road Law
- Off Road Training
- Load Restraint
- Pre Operational Checks/cabin checks
- Observations
- Starting/stopping sequence
- City/Highway driving
- Turning and handling
- 90 degree turns
- Reversing
- Systems of vehicle control/braking distances
- Lane management/following distances
- Maintaining safe speed/safe group
- LR licence testing

Please note training is for a 1 Day, which consists of training and assessment.

If further training is required additional arrangements must be made with Aust-Link staff.

Aust-Link will issue a Statement of Attainment to successful participant on completion of this program.

This training may be delivered with Victorian and Commonwealth Government subsidised funding for eligible applicants.
