

### **PROGRAM OUTLINE**

This accredited VicRoads program is designed for those who have held a current Victorian Motorcycle Learner Permit (for a minimum of 3 months and have successfully completed a Check Ride program prior) and are wishing to obtain their Probationary Motorcycle Licence. Relevant VicRoads testing criteria for skills and practical riding must be reached to a competent standard prior to undertaking the on-road assessment.

### DURATION

2 hours (maximum)

### TRAINER/PARTICIPANT RATIO

1:1 (maximum)

### ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Participants must:

- Hold a current Victorian motorcycle learner permit and have held it for at least three months continuously.
- Bring their Victorian motorcycle learner permit with them on the day of training.
- Provide current drivers licence and a second form of I.D (e.g. Medicare card or birth certificate)
- MUST wear appropriate protective clothing with full skin coverage for riding motorcycles.
  - ✓ Approved helmet
  - ✓ Gloves (not fingerless)
  - ✓ Jeans or trade work pants
  - ✓ Long sleeves
  - ✓ Decent footwear (no slip on or open toe)
- Have completed a Check Ride at least 1 month & 1 day prior (minimum).

If students have their own LAMS Motorcycle, we encourage students to use their own as you will be familiar to how it operates.

Aust-Link can provide a Motorcycle for students to use for Motorcycle Check Ride at no extra charge. (5 Manual & 1 Automatic available per course) Aust-Link also has helmets and gloves available for students to use.

### **PROGRAM OBJECTIVES**

Participants will be tested as required by VicRoads to receive their motorcycle Rider Probationary Licence.

Participants will undergo a riding skill assessment prior to commencement of the On Road Riding Assessment.
