



MOTORCYCLE LICENCE ASSESSMENT 2 HOUR PROGRAM FACT SHEET

DURATION

This program is conducted over 2 hours (maximum)

TRAINER/STUDENT RATIO

1:1 (maximum).

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

1. Be 18 years old
2. Hold a current Victorian Motorcycle Learner Permit and have held it for at least three months continuously.
3. Hold a current Victorian Drivers Licence / Learner Permit
4. Have completed a Motorcycle Check Ride at least 1 month & 1 day prior (minimum).
5. Provide three forms of identity for enrolment paperwork (*Motorcycle Permit, Drivers licence, Medicare, Passport, Birth Cert etc.*)
6. Must notify staff of any medical conditions/medication taken and receive Medical approval from VicRoads
NOTE: VicRoads require all students to declare if they have any Medical Conditions and/or taking any prescribed medications.
A medical report will be required to be submitted to VicRoads Medical for approval prior to the program commencement. Please talk to the friendly Aust-Link staff about VicRoads Medical declarations and requirements.
7. Pass Eyesight test conducted by Aust-Link.
8. MUST wear appropriate protective clothing with full skin coverage for riding motorcycles:
 - ✓ Approved helmet
 - ✓ Gloves (not fingerless)
 - ✓ Pants (Jeans or trade work pants)
 - ✓ Long sleeves (Jacket/Jumper)
 - ✓ Decent footwear that covers ankle (NO slip on or open toe)

PROGRAM FEES & CHARGES

Please contact Aust-Link program coordinator as program fees and charges are subject to change. Fees are broken down into Program Fees, Tuition Fees, Material Fees, Amenities Fees & VicRoads Licence Variation Fee* (*if applicable).

CERTIFICATION

Aust-Link will issue a Statement of Attendance to the successful participant on completion of this program.

PROGRAM OUTLINE & OBJECTIVES

The Motorcycle Licence Assessment is a compulsory component of the VicRoads Motorcycle Graduated Licence System (step 3 of 3).

This accredited VicRoads program is designed for those who have held a current Victorian Motorcycle Learner Permit (*for a minimum of 3 months and have successfully completed a Check Ride program at least 1 month and 1 day prior*) and are wishing to obtain their Probationary Motorcycle Licence.

Relevant VicRoads testing criteria for skills and practical riding must be reached to a competent standard prior to undertaking the on-road assessment.

Students will be tested as required by VicRoads to receive their motorcycle Rider Probationary Licence. Students will undergo a riding skill assessment prior to commencement of the On Road Riding Assessment.

If students have their own LAMS Motorcycle, we encourage students to use their own as you will be familiar to how it operates.

Aust-Link can provide a Motorcycle for students to use for Motorcycle Licence Assessment at no extra charge. (Manual or Automatic available)

Aust-Link also has helmets and gloves available for students to use.
